Currently, Dr. Eley serves as Faculty Administrative Fellow at both Fayetteville State University and the North Carolina System Office, where is actively participating in leadership activities and gaining valuable insight.

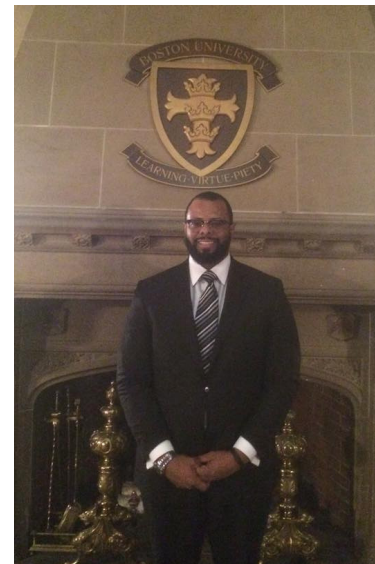
